WALKING WITH GOD

THE DECISION TO ACCEPT CHRIST AS YOUR SAVIOR IS THE MOST IMPORTANT ONE YOU'LL EVER MAKE.

GOD LOVES YOU!

God chose you. He has a plan for your life. He desires to personally know you—inside and out.

For God so loved the world that He gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

JOHN 3:16

. . . We continually thank God for you, our good friends—so loved by God! God picked you out as His from the very start.

GOD VALUES YOU!

All of us were created with an emptiness inside that can only be filled by embracing the reality of how much God loves us. We long to have the assurance that even when we're not perfect, we will still be loved, valued, and accepted by God.

God crowned you with glory, honor, dignity, and worth.

GOD HAS MADE YOU NEW!

You may not feel any different, but when you enter into a relationship with God through Jesus, you become new on the inside. It's a spiritual awakening, and the experience is called being born again. It will take time for the rest of you to catch up, but don't worry! As you grow in your relationship with God, He will change your life.

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a **new** person. The old life is gone; a **new** life has begun!

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17

GOD BRIDGED THE GAP.

Because of sin, a huge, impassable gap exists between us and God. The Bible states that sin is knowing what you should do and not doing it (James 4:17). We try to reconcile with God by being a good person or by following religious rules, but no human effort can make us good enough to fix our separation from God.

Because God loves us so much, His solution was to send His son, Jesus Christ, to bridge that gap between us.

God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

ROMANS 5:8

There is no other way for us to know God other than through Jesus.

Jesus was fully God and fully human, yet He had no sin. Jesus willingly laid down His life and, three days later, rose from the dead. In His death and resurrection, His life paid the price for our sin once and for all.

For it is by GRACE you have been saved through faith. And this is not from yourselves; it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.

GOD'S GRACE IS ENOUGH!

WELCOME TO GOD'S FAMILY!

When you receive Christ, you are born into God's family and given the Holy Spirit. God's Spirit—which guides you and reveals God's truth—lives in you.

You have a new relationship with God, and a new future. All of Heaven is rejoicing—and we are too.

For you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus. And all who have been united with Christ in baptism have put on Christ, like putting on new clothes . . . For you are all one in Christ Jesus.

NEXT STEPS

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Deciding to follow Christ is more than just trying to live a better life. You need to make your faith your own. If your heart or spirit has changed, your outward actions, ambitions, and priorities will follow.

TALK TO GOD

ATTEND CHURCH REGULARLY Connect with others as you learn more about God and His Word.

GET WATER BAPTIZED

Celebrate your new life in Christ by following the example of Jesus. He made his confession of faith public by being water baptized (read Matthew 3:13–17).

SERVE OTHERS

Demonstrate your new life in Christ by serving others. This is the example Jesus gave us while He was on the earth, and it pleases Him when we do the same.

... For even Jesus came not to be served but to serve others...

MATTHEW 20:28

KEEP GROWING

The Bible calls this discipleship. It happens as we stay connected to other believers through small groups and serving, and as we make God our priority in everyday life. Jesus said that when we seek Him above all else, He will give us everything that we need (Matt. 6:33).

I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

JOHN 15:5

SHARE YOUR STORY

Tell others about your decision and the difference God is making in your everyday life. Your story will bring hope and encouragement to others.

And if someone asks about your Christian hope, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way.
